



# DESCENDANTS of WILLIAM NEW of EDGEFIELD DISTRICT, SOUTH CAROLINA

## First Generation

1. **William New** was born in 1775 in North Carolina. He died after 1850 in Edgefield District, South Carolina.

The 1820 census lists William New living in Edgefield District, South Carolina. The record lists 1 male born 1776/1794 [William], 1 male born 1795/1804 [John or William, Jr.], 1 male born 1810/1820 [Name Unknown], 1 female born 1776/1794 [Prudence], and 1 female born 1810-1820 [Name Unknown]. This record indicates that William was living in Edgefield District by 1820.

The following record indicates that William's first wife's name was Prudence: "Edgefield District, State of South Carolina: Benjamin Singleton appoints Lewis Holmes to receive from the admr. of his grandfather Samuel Medlock, his legacy, 27 Dec 1832. [signed] Benjamin Singleton. Wit: William New & Prudence New".

In 1850, the census finds the family living in Edgefield District, South Carolina and lists William New (75, farmer), Elizabeth (30), Joseph (9), and William (1). This census indicates that, obviously, Elizabeth was his second wife.

While the first English settlers, sailing from Barbados, landed on the coast of what is now South Carolina in 1670 to found the towns of Charles Town and Port Royal, central and upstate South Carolina remained a "frontier" region until after 1800. In 1761, the Cherokee land cessions opened the upstate to settlement and new settlers, primarily from Pennsylvania, Virginia, and North Carolina flooded in. William apparently was one of these.

The 1850 census for William New, and later census records for his children, clearly indicate that he was born in North Carolina. There were numerous New families in eastern North Carolina prior to 1790

when the first census was taken. William may have hailed from one of these. But, no records have yet been found that pre-date the 1820 census that finds him in Edgefield District, South Carolina.

As upstate South Carolina opened to settlement, in 1769 Ninety-Six District was created as the judicial subdivision for the large area between the Broad and Savannah Rivers, centered on the small community of Ninety-Six. As the population increased, in 1785 Ninety-Six District was subdivided into Abbeville, Edgefield, Newberry, Laurens, Union, and Spartanburg Counties. Then, in 1800, Ninety-Six District was abolished and these earlier "counties" were designated as "districts". This arrangement lasted until 1868 when each district was re-designated as a "county". Thus, in the records, you will see the same area called both a county and a district at different times. Starting in 1871, as new counties were formed, Edgefield County lost area...first to Aiken County in 1871 and then to Saluda County (1895), Dorchester County (1897), and McCormick County (1916).

Many of the towns that were populated by the New family in Edgefield County became part of Aiken County in 1871...including Gregg and Windsor...while others, like Johnston, Warrenton, and Edgefield, remained in Edgefield County.

William married (1) **Prudence**. Prudence was born in 1776/1794. She died after 1832 in Edgefield District South Carolina.

They had the following children:

- + 2 M i. **John New** was born about 1792.
- 3 M ii. **William New Jr.** was born in 1791/1800 in Edgefield District South Carolina.

The 1830 census lists a William New family living in Edgefield District, South Carolina that includes 1 male born 1791/1800, 1 male born 1825/1830, 1 female born 1791/1800, 1 female born 1816/1820, and 1 female born 1821/1830.

In 1840, the family is living in Edgefield District, South Carolina and the census lists 1 male born 1781/1790, 1 male born 1811/1820, 1 male born 1821/1825, and 1 female born 1821/1825.

Evidently, William's wife died sometime between 1830 and 1840.

William married **Unknown** in 1810/1815 in Edgefield District South Carolina.

- 4 M iii. **Son New** was born in 1810/1820 in Edgefield District, South Carolina.
- 5 F iv. **Daughter New** was born in 1810/1820 in Edgefield District, South Carolina.

William married (2) **Elizabeth** after 1840 in South Carolina. Elizabeth was born about 1820 in South Carolina.

They had the following children:

- + 6 M v. **Joseph New** was born about 1841.
- 7 M vi. **William New** was born about 1849 in Edgefield District South Carolina.

## Second Generation

2. **John New** (William) was born about 1792 in South Carolina.

The 1850 census lists the family living in The District, Edgefield, South Carolina and includes John New (58), Nancy (40), Eugenia (19), Edmond (10), Moses (8), Benjamin (7), Martha (6), Pickens (5), and Margaret (4). Living with family is Lucinda [Busbee] New (21), John's daughter-in-law, and John Edge (70), who is probably Nancy's father.

John married **Nancy Edge** about 1821. Nancy was born about 1810 in South Carolina.

They had the following children:

- + 8 M i. **Joseph New** was born in 1822/1828. He died after 1900.
- + 9 M ii. **John A. New** was born in Nov 1828. He died after 1900.
- 10 F iii. **Eugenia New** was born about 1831 in South Carolina.

- 12 M v. **Edmond New** was born about 1840 in South Carolina.
- + 13 M vi. **Moses New** was born in 1836/1842.
- 14 M vii. **Benjamin New** was born about 1843 in South Carolina.
- 15 F viii. **Martha New** was born about 1844 in South Carolina.
- 16 M ix. **Pickens New** was born in 1840/1845 in South Carolina.

Pickens served as a Private in Company K, 24th Regiment, South Carolina Infantry during the Civil War.

In the 1870 census, we find Pickens New (30, farm laborer) living with his brother Moses' family in Saluda, Edgefield, South Carolina.
- 17 F x. **Margaret New** was born about 1846 in South Carolina.

6. **Joseph New** (William) was born about 1841 in Edgefield District South Carolina.

The 1880 census finds the family living in Langley, Aiken, South Carolina and lists Joseph New (42, farm hand), Leoinia (39), Josephine (16), Lorena (12), Wm. H. (9), and B.W. (7).

Joseph married **Leona** . Leona was born about 1841 in South Carolina.

They had the following children:

- 18 F i. **Josephine New** was born about 1864 in South Carolina.
- 19 F ii. **Lorena New** was born about 1868 in South Carolina.
- 20 M iii. **William H. New** was born about 1871 in South Carolina.
- 21 M iv. **B.W. New** was born about 1873 in South Carolina.

## Third Generation

8. **Joseph New** (John, William) was born in 1822/1828 in South Carolina. He died after 1900 in Johnston, Edgefield, South Carolina. He was buried in Phillipi Baptist Church Cemetery, Johnston, Edgefield, South Carolina.

In 1860, the census lists the family living in Edgefield, Edgefield, South Carolina and includes Joseph New (29, farmer), Lucinda (29), Idonia (9), Jno. A. (7), Wm. J. (3), and Thos. K. (1).

There is a record that Joseph New served first in Co. F and then in Co. A, 7th South Carolina Infantry Regiment during the Civil War.

The book, "SC Confederate Pensioners of 1901", lists Joseph New, Aiken, Co. F 7th Reg, wounded in arm, listed as Saluda Co. Class C No. 2. Also he was listed as Joseph New, Trenton, Co. K 19th SCV, age 73 y/o, Aiken Co. Class C No. 1. The marker on Joseph's grave lists him as serving with the Confederate Army in the 7th Infantry, Company F.

The 1870 census finds the family living in Shaws, Edgefield, South Carolina and lists Joseph New (48, farmer), Lucinda (40), Donia (18), John (16), William (12), Wade P. (9), Joanna (6), Georgia Ann (4), Lucinda E. (2), and Eliza (9/12). Since Thomas is not listed in this census, it is assumed that he died young.

In 1880, the family is living in Shaws, Edgefield, South Carolina. The census record includes Joseph New (52, farmer), Lucinda (50), Preston (19), Joanna (16), Gerogia (14), Ella (12), and Louisa (10).

The 1900 census lists the family living in Shaws, Edgefield, South Carolina and includes Joseph Stanford (72, farmer), Lucindy (71), and Ella (32).

Joseph married **Lucinda Busbee** about 1849. Lucinda was born in May 1829/1830 in Edgefield District, South Carolina. She died after 1900 in South Carolina.

They had the following children:

- 22 F     i. **Peolina Donia New** was born on 18 Jun 1850 in South Carolina. She died on 5 Dec 1937 in Aiken County, South Carolina. She was buried in Phillipi Baptist Church Cemetery, Johnston, Aiken, South Carolina.  
  
Peolina married **Benjamin Day** . Benjamin was born on 10 Jan 1855 in South Carolina. He died on 3 May 1932 in Aiken County, South Carolina. He was buried in Phillipi Baptist Church Cemetery, Johnston, Aiken, South Carolina.
- 23 M     ii. **John A. New** was born about 1853 in South Carolina.
- +     24 M     iii. **William J. New** was born about 1857.
- 25 M     iv. **Thomas K. New** was born about 1859 in Edgefield District South Carolina. He died before 1870 in Edgefield District South Carolina.
- 26 F     v. **Joanna New** was born on 11 Dec 1859 in Trenton, Edgefield, South Carolina. She died on 17 Jul 1951 in South Carolina. She was buried in St. Mark's Lutheran Church, Lexington County, South Carolina.

Joanna married **John Franklin McNure** about 1890. John was born on 18 May 1853 in Lexington County, South Carolina. He died on 5 Oct 1936 in Newberry County, South Carolina. He was buried in St. Mark's Lutheran Church, Lexington County, South Carolina.

+ 27 M vi. **Wade Preston New** was born on 23 Apr 1861. He died on 1 Jul 1909.

28 F vii. **Georgia Ann New** was born about 1866 in South Carolina.

29 F viii. **Lucinda Ella New** was born in Jul 1868 in South Carolina. She died on 22 Feb 1937 in Aiken County, South Carolina.

Ella never married.

The 1910 census finds Eller New (42) living with Launce and L.L. Day in Shaws, Aiken, South Carolina. The record lists her as "aunt".

In the 1930 census, we find Lucindy Ella New (63) living with Willie A. and Addie Aultman in Shaws, Aiken, South Carolina. In this record she is listed as "aunt".

30 F ix. **Louisa New** was born about 1870.

9. **John A. New** (John, William) was born in Nov 1828 in South Carolina. He died after 1900 in Aiken County, South Carolina. He was buried in Private Cemetery, Square Circle Rd, Graniteville, Aiken, South Carolina.

The 1860 census lists John New (34, day laborer) living with the family of J.G. and Lucy Able in Lexington County. This record indicates he was born in Edgefield County, South Carolina.

There is a record for John New serving as a Private in Co. C of the 7th South Carolina Infantry Regiment during the Civil War.

The 1900 census finds the family living in Gregg, Aiken, South Carolina and lists John New (71, wood cutter), Catherine (25), Oscar (9), Cyrus (6), Lonney (5), and Harvey (2).

John's grave is marked with a Civil War marker bearing the inscription " John New, Co. F, 7th SC Inf."

John married **Catherine Floyd** about 1889 in South Carolina. Catherine was born in Jan 1864 in South Carolina. She died in 1926 in South Carolina. She was buried in Graniteville Cemetery, Graniteville, Aiken, South Carolina.

They had the following children:

+ 31 M i. **Oscar Starlyn New** was born on 2 Jun 1890. He died in Nov 1966.

32 M ii. **Silas New** was born on 4 May 1892 in Warrentville, South Carolina. He died

on 5 Feb 1951 in Graniteville, Aiken, South Carolina. He was buried in Graniteville Cemetery, Graniteville, Aiken, South Carolina.

Silas served as a Private in 1st Corps Artillery during WWI.

The 1930 census lists the family living in Gregg, Aiken, South Carolina and includes Silas New (39, carding, cotton mill) and Annie (38 (carding, cotton mill)).

Evidently, Silas and Annie had no children.

Silas married **Annie L. Minor** about 1922 in South Carolina. Annie was born on 26 Apr 1891 in South Carolina. She died on 19 Oct 1940 in South Carolina. She was buried in Graniteville Cemetery, Graniteville, South Carolina.

33 M   iii. **Cyrus P. New** was born in May 1894 in Edgefield County, South Carolina.

The 1920 census lists C.P. New (26, auto mechanic) and his wife Ruth (25) living in Augusta Ward 1, Richmond, Georgia.

Cyrus married **Ruth**. Ruth was born about 1895 in South Carolina.

+   34 M   iv. **Lonnie New** was born on 2 Jan 1895. He died on 7 Jul 1959.

35 M   v. **Harvey New** was born in Mar 1898 in Warrenton, Aiken, South Carolina.

11. **Edward G. New** (John, William) was born in 1830/1833 in Edgefield County, South Carolina. He died after 1880 in Aiken County, South Carolina.

In 1860, the census finds the family living in Saluda Regiment, Edgefield, South Carolina and lists E.G. New (28, farm laborer), Martha (22), N.J. (4), Whitfield (3), and J. W. (5/12).

Edward G. New served as a Private in Company B, 6th South Carolina Cavalry Regiment (Aiken's Partisan Rangers) during the Civil War.

An Edward New also served as a Private in Co. F and then Co. C of the 7th Regiment, South Carolina Infantry.

The 1870 census lists the family in Saluda, Edgefield, South Carolina. This record includes Edward New (37, farm laborer), Martha (35), Whitfield (13), Wesley (11), Henry (9), Ella (2) and Elizabeth (b. Dec 1869). Living with the family is Margaret New (24) and James Barronton (5), relationships unknown.

In 1880, the census records for Shaw, Aiken, South Carolina include Edward New (50, laborer), Marther (35), Moses (23), John (22), Henry (18), Joe (6), Presly (4), Josephine (11), Lizabeth (12), Mandy (8), and daughter-in-law Tena New (25).

Edward married **Martha Prescott** on 8 Jul 1855 in Edgefield District, South Carolina. Martha was born in 1835/1838 in South Carolina.

They had the following children:

36 F   i. **N. J. New** was born about 1856 in Edgefield District, South Carolina. She died before 1870 in Edgefield District, South Carolina.

This child appears in the 1860 census, but not the 1870 census. It is assumed that she died by then.

37 M   ii. **Whitfield Moses New** was born about 1857 in Edgefield District, South Carolina.

38 M   iii. **John Wesley New** was born about 1860 in Edgefield District, South Carolina.

39 M   iv. **Henry New** was born about 1861 in Edgefield District, South Carolina.

- 40 F v. **Josephine Ella New** was born about 1868 in Edgefield District, South Carolina.
- 41 F vi. **Elizabeth New** was born about 1869 in Edgefield County, South Carolina.
- 42 F vii. **Amanda New** was born about 1872 in Edgefield County, South Carolina.
- 43 M viii. **Joseph New** was born about 1874 in Edgefield County, South Carolina.
- + 44 M ix. **Preston New** was born on 3 Aug 1876. He died on 5 Apr 1930.

13. **Moses New** (John, William) was born in 1836/1842 in South Carolina.

The 1870 census finds the family living in Saluda, Edgefield, South Carolina and lists Moses New (34, farm laborer), Sarah (30), and James (3). Living with the family is Pickens New (30, farm laborer), Moses' brother.

Moses married **Sarah** . Sarah was born about 1840 in South Carolina.

They had the following children:

- 45 M i. **James New** was born about 1867 in South Carolina.

## Fourth Generation

24. **William J. New** (Joseph, John, William) was born about 1857 in South Carolina.

In 1880, the census finds the family living in Shaws, Edgefield, South Carolina and lists William New (22, farm hand), Mealia (20), and America (1).

William married **Permealia** . Permealia was born in Jul 1859.

They had the following children:

- 46 F i. **America New** was born about 1879 in South Carolina.
- 47 F ii. **Kate New** was born in Dec 1881.
- 48 F iii. **Leila New** was born in Jul 1885.

27. **Wade Preston New** (Joseph, John, William) was born on 23 Apr 1861 in Edgefield District, South Carolina. He died on 1 Jul 1909 in Edgefield County, South Carolina. He was buried on 2 Jul 1909 in Phillipi Baptist Church Cemetery, Johnston, Edgefield, South Carolina.

The 1900 census lists the family living in Shaw, Edgefield, South Carolina and includes Preston New (39, farmer), Josie (33), Darling (14), Preston (11), Bunyon (5), and Georgia (1).

Wade married **Josephine Cotton** "Josie" about 1882 in South Carolina. Josephine was born in Jan 1867 in Edgefield County, South Carolina. She died before 1917 in South Carolina.

In 1910, the census finds the family living in Gregg, Aiken, South Carolina and lists Josephine New (46, widow), Cornel (20, carder, cotton mill), Bunion (16, carder, cotton mill), Georgia B. (10), and Eula M. (3).

Since Bunyon New's 1917 WWI draft registration and the 1920 census both indicate that he has his

sister Eula Mae New living with his family and Cournel's registration shows that his sister [Georgia Bell] was living with his family. This appears to indicate that Josephine died before 1917.

Wade and Josephine had the following children:

- 53 M v. **Price New** was born on 18 Sep 1894 in Edgefield County, South Carolina. He died on 2 Jul 1896 in Edgefield County, South Carolina. He was buried in Phillipi Baptist Church Cementary, Johnston, Edgefield, South Carolina.
- 54 F vi. **Georgia Belle New** was born in Jan 1899 in Edgefield County, South Carolina.  

Apparently, the sister listed on the WW1 registration card for Cournel Preston New was Georgia Belle New. If this is so, she was living with Cournel and his wife, Ruth, on June 5, 1917 in Aiken, SC.
- 55 F vii. **Annie Belle New** was born on 3 Jul 1904 in Edgefield County, South Carolina. She died on 3 Nov 1904 in Edgefield, South Carolina. She was buried in Phillipi Baptist Church Cementary, Johnston, South Carolina.
- 56 F viii. **Eula Mae New** was born on 25 Jan 1907 in Edgefield County, South Carolina. She died on 17 Oct 1978 in Charlotte, Mecklenburg, North Carolina. She was buried in Forest Lawn Cemetery, Charlotte, Mecklenburg, North Carolina.

Eula married **Herbert Warren Stanford** about 1923. Herbert was born on 9 Apr 1905 in Augusta, Ga. He died in Aug 1979 in Augusta, Ga. He was buried in Forest Lawn Cemetery, Charlotte, Mecklenburg, North Carolina.

31. **Oscar Starlyn New "Pete"** (John A., John, William) was born on 2 Jun 1890 in Warrentville, Aiken, South Carolina. He died in Nov 1966 in Bamberg, Bamberg, South Carolina. He was buried in Graniteville Cemetery, Graniteville, Aiken, South Carolina.

Oscar married **Annie Mae Thurmond** on 23 Dec 1914 in Warrentville, Aiken, South Carolina. Annie was born on 15 May 1898 in Edgefield, South Carolina. She died on 8 Jun



1981 in Bamberg, Bamberg, South Carolina. She was buried in Graniteville Cemetery, Graniteville, Aiken, South Carolina.

Annie was the daughter of George Washington Thurmond (1853-1930) and Annie Martha McClendon (1879-1929).

Oscar and Annie had the following children:

Lonnie married **Kular (Glaze) Johnson** about 1918. Kular was born on 16 May 1896 in South Carolina. She died on 28 Feb 1937 in South Carolina. She was buried in Graniteville Cemetery, Graniteville, Aiken, South Carolina.

They had the following children:

- 61 M     i. **Franklin New** was born on 23 Aug 1919 in South Carolina. He died on 28 Jun 1934 in South Carolina. He was buried in Graniteville Cemetery, Graniteville, Aiken, South Carolina.

John married **Nellie N. Thompson** on 18 Mar 1953 in Aiken County, South Carolina. Nellie was born on 29 Feb 1916. She died on 26 Feb 1989. She was buried in Graniteville Cemetery, Graniteville, South Carolina.

- +     63 M     iii. **Edward J. C. New** was born on 20 Sep 1923. He died on 2 May 1987.
- +     64 M     iv. **Alfred Rudolph New** was born on 3 Oct 1927. He died on 27 Sep 1993.

44. **Preston New** "Press" (Edward G., John, William) was born on 3 Aug 1876 in Edgefield County, South Carolina. He died on 5 Apr 1930 in Aiken, Aiken, South Carolina.

In 1900, the census lists the family living in Shaws, Aiken, South Carolina and includes Preston New (22, driver, log cart), Sarah (20), Cornelia (4), and Eva (11/12).

The 1910 census finds the family living in Aiken, Aiken, South Carolina and lists Preston New (30, farmer), Sarah (33), Effie (13), Eva (10), Sarah (8), Wade (5), John Henry (4), and Bessie (11/12).

On 12 Sep 1918, Preston registered for the WWI draft in Aiken County, South Carolina. IN this record he listed his birth date as 3 Aug 1876, his wife's name as Sarah, and his occupations as "farm laborer". Since this record is signed with an "X", apparently Preston could not read or write.

Preston married **Sarah Day** about 1896 in South Carolina. Sarah was born in Nov 1880 in Shaws, Aiken, South Carolina. She died on 30 Mar 1969.

They had the following children:

- 65 F     i. **Cornelia New** "Effie" was born in Apr 1896 in Aiken County, South Carolina.
  
- 66 F     ii. **Eva New** was born on 9 Aug 1899 in Aiken County, South Carolina. She died on 22 Apr 1992 in Aiken, Aiken, South Carolina.  
Eva married **Levi Bonnett** on 7 Oct 1917 in Windsor, Aiken, South Carolina. Levi was born on 3 Sep 1874 in Barnwell, Barwell, South Crolina. He died on 7 Jan 1950 in Windsor, Aiken, South Carolina.  

Levi was the son of Samuel Duffin Bonnett (1854-1908) and Elizabeth Permatiss Goss (1856-1929).

49. **Darling Wardlaw New** (Wade Preston, Joseph, John, William) was born on 2 Jul 1886 in Edgefield County, South Carolina. He died on 12 Jun 1947 in Aiken County, South Carolina. He was buried on 14 Jun 1947 in Phillipi Baptist Church Cementary, Johnston, Edgefield, South Carolina.

Some family members say Darling ran Estelle off because his boys kept propositioning her. No divorce decree or a death record for Estelle has been found.

The 1910 census lists the family living in Ward, Edgefield, south Carolina and includes Darling New (24, carpenter), Hattie (18), Henry (2) and Herman (5/12).

Darling's WWI draft registration card lists his date of birth as July 2, 1884 and his place of birth as Johnston, Edgefield County, SC. He registered on Sept. 15, 1918.

In 1920, the census finds the family living in Shaws, Edgefield, South Carolina and lists Darling New (37, farmer), Hattie (24), Henry (12), Hunter (9), Lewis (7), Hattie Mae (4-8/12), Willie (6), and Woodrow (1-3/12).
