# LEVERETT ALFONSO WHITE

of

**Nobles County, Minnesota**

Leverett Alfonso White was born in New York in 1851 and moved to Illinois with his parents sometime about 1857. There, he married Barbara Helen "Nellie" Borst in 1880. Based on census information and birth data, it appears that Alfonso and Nellie moved to Iowa about 1881/1883 and to Minnesota about 1891/1892, settling in Bigelow, Nobles, Minnesota. The large White family of Nobles County today are all descendants of Leverett and Nellie.

Leverett was the descendent of a prominent New England family whose immigrant ancestor was Elder John White who landed at Boston, Massachusetts in 1632. Elder White and his descendents, including Leverett, are recorded in the book *Memorials of Elder John White, One of the First Settlers of Hartford, Conn. and His Descendants* by Allyn Stanley Kellogg, published in 1860. (This book has been reprinted and is currently available from Amazon.com.)

The following summarizes Leverett's ancestors and attempts to record as much information as possible about his descendants to date:

## First Generation

1. **John White** was born after 1596 in England. He died in Dec 1683/1684 in Hartford, Hartford, Connecticut.

John was the immigrant ancestor of the White family. He arrived in Boston, Massachusetts in 1632 aboard the vessel "Lyon", commanded by Capt. Pierce, and initially settled in Cambridge, Middlesex, Massachusetts.

John's will is dated 17 Dec 1683 and his estate was inventoried on 23 Jan 1684, which bracket is date of death.

John's date of birth can be approximately established in that his father's will states that John is not yet 21 in June 1617. Various sources list his date of birth from 1600/1605.

".....Elder John White (1605-1683-1684), who came from England in 1632 on the ship "Lyon" and, after living in Cambridge (then Newtown), Massachusetts, where he was admitted freeman in 1633 and townsman in 1635, removed to Hartford, Connecticut, in 1636, as one of the original proprietors. He was frequently townsman there as well as at Hadley, Massachusetts, whither he moved in 1659. In 1671 he returned to Hartford and was ordained ruling elder of the Second Church in 1677."

Source of the following: "Descendants of John White in the Line of Ensign Daniel White of Middletown, Supplementary to Memorials of Elder John White", Edward Wade Carman:

". . . . John White found his first home in this western world. His home lot, with his dwelling house, was on the street then called Cow-Yard Row. This home lot contained about three-quarters of an acre of land, and was early allotted to him, together with about thirty acres of farming lands. On the 5th of August, 1633, three-quarters of an acre more, near his home lot, was granted to him by the town, for a cow-yard. "Gore Hall", the beautiful library building of Harvard University, probably now graces this cow-yard. If not on the identical site, it is, beyond a doubt, very near to it. . . ."

". . . . In the records of Hartford, John White appears as one of the original proprietors. His allotments consisted--as nearly as can be determined from the records -- of his house lot, containing about two acres, of about forty acres of meadow, about thirty-two acres of upland, ten acres of swamp and one hundred and fifty acres of upland at Hockanum, east of the Great River. . . ."

". . . . At Hartford he was again called into public service. In 1642 he was chosen one of the selectmen of the town -- or 'orderers' as these officers were at first called - and again in 1646, in 1651, and in 1656. His name also appears frequently on the record of the Courts, as a juror, or as an arbitrator in the settlement of private differences. . . ."

". . . . On the 18th of April, 1659, sixty persons, from Hartford and Wethersfield, signed the agreement to remove to Hadley. The place of John White's name, as the fifth on the list, indicates that he was among the leaders of that important movement. . . ."

". . . . he was chosen one of the selectmen in 1662, in 1663, and in 1665. He also served the town in 1664 and in 1669, as Representative -- or Deputy, as it was then styled -- to the General Court of Legislature of Massachusetts, sitting in Boston. . . ."

". . . . and it was probably during this year (1670) that he returned to Hartford. . . ."

". . . . After his return to Hartford his name does not appear again upon the records, as holding civil office or performing civil services. The office of Elder then exempted him who bore it from all duties of

this kind. But as an arbitrator, referee, and council in ecclesiastical matters, he performed good service to the churches. In 1676, and in 1677, he and his eldest son Nathaniel, then of Middletown, were members of the council called to hear the difficulty which had long troubled the ancient church in Windsor; and the final recommendation of the council, with the autograph signature of its members, may be seen in the archives of the State, at Hartford."

Following from "Samuel Richardson and Josiah Ellsworth", page 744

"....John was not of age when his father made his will in which he provided that if he should marry without the approval of his mother and brothers-in-laws, Joseph Loomis of Braintree and William Goodwin of Bocking his legacy of 200 pounds would be reduced to 100 pounds. He Selectman at Cambridge 1635; at Hartford 1642, 46, 51, 56; Selectman at Hadley 1662; Deputy to General Court 1664 & 1669. Received into Second Church Hartford from Hadley Apr. 9, 1671. Ordained Ruling Elder march 1677. They lived in Cambridge where the Harvard Library Gore Hall now stands. It is said 'The shadow of the Charter Oak' fell on John White's house. It was next to Gov. Hopkins & near that of Gov. Wyllys. John White's name is on the Hartford Monument. His will is dated Dec. 17, 1683."

Invt. 190-09-00. Taken 23 January, 1683-4, by Nathaniel Standly, Steven Hosmer, Thomas Bunce. Will dated 17 December, 1683.

"I Mr. John White of Hartford do make this my last Will & Testament: I give unto my son Nathaniel  $\square$ 30 and my best broad Cloath Coate, & also give him My iron bound chest in my Chamber, & my Cobirons in my parlour, & that part of my oxpasture which lyeth on the Left hand of the way as we go to Wethersfield, bounded upon the highway, next Henry Grime's Land North, Mr. Nickolls his Land South, the South Meadow East. I give to my son Daniel White 20 pounds. I give to my son Jacob White that part of my ox pasture in Hartford which lyeth on the right hand of the way Leading to Wethersfield, bounded East by the highway, by Jonathan Bygelow his Land south, by Henry Grimes his Land North, & Lt. Webster's Land West. I impower my Executor to give to my daughter Hixton according to his discretion as he shall see her need calls for. Whereas I intended to give a parcel of meadow Land in Great Ponsett to Stephen Taylor, yet now being forced to pay a great summe of money for the Redemption of his house & home lott, now see cause to dispose of that Land for the payment of that debt, and shall leave to my Executor with the advice of the Overseers to give either to him or the rest of my daughter Hixton's Children. I give to my grand child Stephen Taylor things at Nathaniel White's, at Hadly. I give to Sarah White, the daughter of my son Nathaniel White, 5 pounds. I give to Mr. John Whiting, my honoured Pastor, 5 pounds in silver. The remainder of my estate shall be divided among my Grand Children (viz.): Jonathan Gilbert, son of my daughter Mary, my son Nathaniel's Children, my son John's Children, my son Daniel's Children, & my daughter Sarah's Children. I appoint my son Nathaniel White to be sole Executor, & Ensign Nathaniel Stanly and Stephen Hosmer to be Overseers.

3. **Nathaniel White** (John) was born about 1629 in Shalford, Essex, England. He died on 27 Aug 1711 in Middletown, Middlesex, Connecticut. He was buried in Middletown, Middlesex, Connecticut.

The following is from "Memorials of Elder John White" by Allyn S. Kellogg, 1860:

"...In 1650 or 1651, when about twenty-one years old, he removed to Middletown, on the Connecticut river, being one of the original proprietors and first settlers of that town. His homelot was in that part of Middletown formerly called "Upper Houses" and afterwards "Upper Middletown", now constituting the

town of Cromwell, CT. His dwelling-house was in the lower part of the village, on the street that lies between the Middlesex turnpike and the Connecticut River.

"He early acquired great influence and was among the leading men of that section of the Colony. In civil life he was almost constantly employed in some of the various town offices and also stately represented the town in the Legislature (or General Court, as it was at first called) of the Colony. He was first chosen in 1659, when about thirty years of age, and from 1661 to 1710, a period of fifty years, he was chosen Deputy once every year, and often twice; the Legislature then meeting semi-annually, in May and October of each year, and a new election being held for each session. The only exception to his regular election was in the year 1688, when, in consequence of the usurpation of sir Edmund Andross, there were no elections by the people. He was elected a representative from Middletown eighty-five times, and was eighty-one years old when last chosen. Very few instances can be found of so long an official life dependent on annual popular elections; probably no other, in which the same political community, by a majority of all its voters, has elected the same individual its representative in the Legislature of the State eighty-five times. Such facts as this have secured for Connecticut the appellation of the 'Land o Steady Habits'. In 1669 Nathaniel White was appointed by the Legislature a magistrate and commissioner for Middletown, and in 1684 for Middletown, Haddam and the District of Meriden; and he held local courts for these places. In military life he rose through successive grades to the rank of Captain, the title of which office he carried with him through life.

"It is evident from the nature of the public services he rendered, traces of which are found in the records of the town and of the Colony, that he was a man of ability and education, and that he deserved the great and long-continued confidence reposed in him by his fellow citizens. The Rev. Dr. Field, in his address on the two-hundredth anniversary of the settlement of Middletown, says of him, that 'he was a man of high religious character and sound judgement.'

"He died Aug. 27, 1711, 'aged about 82', as the inscription on his monument informs us. His grave is in Middletown City, in the burying-ground near the river. In his will, which was dated Aug. 16, 1711, after some other bequests, he gives one-fourth of his undivided lands 'to remain for the use of the Publick School already agreed upon in the Town of Middletown, forever'. Respecting certain other provisions of his will, he makes this statement: 'And the reason why I say my daughters shall have each of them one-third of what moveable household goods was in being when my former wife dyed, is because I intend that what my now wife hath gained by her Industry, and what she brought with her to me, should be at her own dispose.' He owned about 1500 acres of land, and was for a long time the second in property in the town. The inventory of his estate amounted to 927 pounds 11s 5d."

Nathaniel married (1) **Elizabeth Bunce** about 1650 in Hartford, Hartford, Connecticut. Elizabeth was born about 1634 in Middletown, Middlesex, Connecticut. She died about 1690 in Middletown, Middlesex, Connecticut.

This was Martha's second marriage...she was the widow of Hugh Mould of New London, Connecticut and the daughter of John Coit and Mary [Jenners ?].

- 14. **Jacob White** (Nathaniel, John) was born on 10 May 1665 in Middletown, Middlesex, Connecticut. He died on 29 Mar 1738 in Middletown, Middlesex, Connecticut.

Jacob married (1) **Deborah Shepard** on 4 Feb 1692 in Middletown, Middlesex, Connecticut. Deborah was born about 1669 in Cambridge, Middlesex, Massachusetts. She died on 8 Feb 1721 in Hartford, Hartford, Connecticut.

They had the following children:

21. **Thomas White** (Jacob, Nathaniel, John) was born on 14 Aug 1701 in Middletown, Middlesex, Connecticut. He died about 1773 in Coventry, Island, Connecticut.

According to the "Memorials of Elder John White" by Allyn S. Kellogg, 1860: "He settled as a farmer in East Middletown (Chatham, Middlesex, CT), but in 1731 removed to the north part of the town of Lebanon, Conn., within the present town of Andover. His farm lay on both sides of Hop River, and was partly in the town of Coventry, Tolland, CT. About 1748 he removed to Coventry, Tolland, CT, east of the Skungamug River."

Thomas married (1) **Sarah Miller** on 23 Dec 1725 in Middletown, Middlesex, Connecticut. Sarah was born about 1699 in Wethersfield, Hartford, Connecticut. She died on 10 Aug 1736 in Middletown, Middlesex, Connecticut.

36. **Silas White** (Thomas, Jacob, Nathaniel, John) was born on 18 May 1745 in Lebanon, New London, Connecticut. He died about 1802 in New Hartford, Litchfield, Connecticut.

Silas was a soldier in the Revolutionary War.

The 1800 census lists the family of Silas White living in New Hartford, Litchfield, Connecticut and includes 2 M < 10 [Lester and Percy], 1 M 45+ [Silas], and 1 F 26-44 [Hannah].

Silas married (1) **Mary Birge** about 1770 in Torrington, Litchfield, Connecticut. Mary was born on 31 Oct 1752 in Torrington, Litchfield, Connecticut. She died on 20 Apr 1790 in Torrington, Litchfield, Connecticut.

They had the following children:

41. **Chauncey White** (Silas, Thomas, Jacob, Nathaniel, John) was born on 11 Sep 1783 in Torrington, Litchfield, Connecticut. He died after 1860 in Westmoreland, Oneida, New York .

The "Memorials of Elder John White" indicate that the family moved to Hampden County, Massachusetts about 1810/1815.

In 1850, the census finds the family living in Westmoreland, Oneida, New York and lists Chauncey White (66, tailor) and Melinda White (64).

The 1860 census finds Chauncey White (76, tailor) living alone in Westmoreland, Oneida, New York.

Chauncey married (1) **Elizabeth Plumb "Betsey"** on 5 Mar 1804. Elizabeth was born about 1781 in Litchfield, Litchfield, Connecticut. She died on 22 May 1822 in Connecticut.

Betsey was the daughter of Ebenezer Plumb (1747-1829) and Deborah Griswold (1747-1836).

Chauncey and Elizabeth had the following children:

+ 46 M i. **Charles Plumb White** was born on 4 Aug 1809. He died after 1860.

47 M ii. **Orrin White** .

Orrin died at the age of 4.

48 F iii. **Jane Eliza White** was born on 27 Dec 1815 in Massachusetts. She died after 1880 in Bloomingdale, DuPage, Illinois.

The 1880 census finds Jane Coe (64) and her husband Harvey (68) living with her daughter and son-in-law Larin and Jane Barnes in Bloomingdale, DuPage, Illinois.

Jane married **Harvey Coe** on 24 Sep 1834 in Massachusetts. Harvey was born about 1812 in Massachusetts. He died after 1880 in Bloomingdale, DuPage, Illinois.

Chauncey married (2) **Melinda Taylor** on 10 Dec 1823 in Granville, Hampden, Massachusetts. Melinda was born about 1786 in Massachusetts. She died after 1850 in Westmoreland, Oneida, New York .

Melinda was the widow of George Taylor of Granville, Hampden, Massachusetts.

Chauncey and Melinda had the following children:

49 F iv. **Harriet Elizabeth White** was born in Sep 1825/1826 in Connecticut. She died on 25 May 1844 in Connecticut or New York.

## Seventh Generation

46. **Charles Plumb White** (Chauncey, Silas, Thomas, Jacob, Nathaniel, John) was born on 4 Aug 1809 in Winchester, Litchfield, Connecticut. He died after 1860 in Illinois or Iowa.

Since their first four children were born in Massachusetts, it is probable that Charles and Mercy were married there...both families lived in Hampden County, Massachusetts in 1830. They moved to New York about 1839/1840.

According to "Memorials of Elder John White" by Allyn S. Kellogg, 1860, "He [Charles] is a shoemaker; has lived in Lenox and Marcellus, Onondaga Co., N.Y.; removed in 1857 to Belvidere, Boone Co., IL." [This is not totally correct...there is no Boone County, but the family did move to Illinois.]



The 1850 census finds the family living in Marcellus, Onodaga, New York and includes Charles P. White (40, farmer), Mercy A. (37), Almira B. (14), Sarah A. (14), William C. (13), Charlotte S. (11), Philena C. (10), Ivery S. (8), Harriet E. (6), Norman H. (4), Charles O. (2), and James O. (11/12).

In 1860, the family is living in Guilford, Winnebago, Illinois. The census record includes Charles P. White (49, farmer), Mercy A. (47), Charlotte Coffin (21), Stiles (19), Harriet (18), Norman H. (14), Charles O. (12), James O. (10), and Leverett A. (8).

No records for the family after 1860 have been found. There is an 1870 census listing for Cedar, Knox, Illinois that lists a Joel White (69, b. New York) and Mercy White (58, b. New York) that may be applicable.

Charles married **Mercy A. Wilcox** on 10 Oct 1833. Mercy was born about 1813 in Canton, Hartford, Connecticut. She died after 1860 in Illinois or Iowa.

Mercy was the daughter of William Wilcox (1782-1861) and Mercy Rice (1787-1780). In 1830, the family was living in Southwick, Hampden, Massachusetts.

Charles and Mercy had the following children:

57. **Norman H. White** (Charles Plumb, Chauncey, Silas, Thomas, Jacob, Nathaniel, John) was born on 23 Nov 1845 in New York.

In 1880, the census finds Norman White (32) living in Silver Creek, Ida, Iowa with his brother Leverett A. White (25, farmer) and family.

The 1885 Iowa State Census lists the family living in Ida Grove, Ida, Iowa and includes Nathan [Norman] H. White (37, farmer), Allie (31), and Harry E. (2).

Norman married **Allie Borst** on 21 Nov 1881 in Ida Grove, Ida, Iowa. Allie was born about 1862 in Schoharie County, New York. She died on 25 Feb 1913 in Adams, Wapello, Iowa. She was buried in Hopewell Cemetery, Adams, Wapello, Iowa.

Allie was the daughter of Benjamin Borst (b. 1826, Schoharie County, New York, d. 1877, Illinois) and Jane Ann Bice (b. 1830, d. 1887, Illinois).

Norman and Allie had the following children:

62 M     i. **Harry E. White** was born on 17 Jun 1883 in Ida Grove, Ida, Iowa.

In 1905, the Minnesota State Census finds Harry White (b. abt 1883, laborer) living in Worthington, Nobles, Minnesota. This record indicates that he moved to Minnesota in 1901.

In 1910, the census lists Harry White (27, hired help) living and working on the farm of Andrew and Mary Doeden in Bigelow, Nobles, Minnesota.

White was elected as one of the two "constables" for the village of Bigelow, Nobles, Minnesota. [The other constable was John Brink, father of Johanna Brink, who married L.A.'s son Chauncey William White.]

The 1905 Minnesota State Census finds the family in Worthington, Nobles, Minnesota. This record lists Leverett A. White (50, farmer), Nellie (46), Archie A. (18), Walter E. (15), Charley G. (14), and Hazel M. (6). This record indicates the family has lived in the state 14 years.

In 1910, the census finds the family living in Worthington Ward 1, Nobles, Minnesota. This record lists Leverett A. White (56, day laborer, odd jobs), Nellie (50, dress maker), and Hazel M. (10).

The 1920 census lists the family in Worthington Ward 2, Nobles, Minnesota and includes Severett White (62, laborer, creamry), Nellie (60, dress maker), and Hazel (20).

In 1930, the census finds Leverett A. White (75) living with his daughter and son-in-law Hazel White Driscoll and Andrew Driscoll in Worthington, Nobles, Minnesota.
